#### Overview

Athletic Academic Advising (AAA) is a service provided to student-athletes to help assist them with academic needs. Recently, DePaul University established the Degree Progress Report which allows students to track the classes they have taken as well as the future courses needed to complete their major(s) or minor(s). In order to make the meeting process with prospective student-athletes more informational AAA would like to tap into the new technology to provide a different experience when showing curriculum.

#### Milestone One

After deciding on the core features, first prototype should be a fair representation of the user expectations. The prototype will allow for user testing to begin in order to further flush out features or correct concerns.

#### **Milestone Two**

Following the completion of the first prototype, a second prototype was designed eliminating potential functionality and usability issues. Additionally, layout was cleaned up and minor details were updated.

#### Overview

#### **GOALS**

Develop a mobile application similar to DePaul University's current Degree Progress Report: Currently when an AAA advisor meets with a prospective student-athlete and discusses the curriculum they use either a printed copy or the computer screen. A printed copy may not be up-to-date and does not explicitly say which classes satisfy certain requirements, specifically those for the Liberal Studies core (Arts & Lit, Philosophy, Self Society and the Modern World, Understanding the Past, Religious Dimensions, and Scientific Inquiry). Using the computer suffers many of the same issues with the addition to the difficulty to see the actual information due to the distance between the seating and the monitor. A mobile iPad version would allow for more information to be shared in a condensed fashion

while provided an interactive way for the prospective student-athlete to understand the curriculum offered by DePaul University.

#### Criteria

- Minimalist design
- Streamlined, simple to use
- Included all majors and minors offered by DePaul
- Ability to compare two majors
- Amend a major to include a double major or minor
- List of courses that would satisfy a requirement

#### **Prototype One - 5/15/2012**

Initial lo-fi prototype was completed. Prototype was examined to fix design and functionality issues. Used as a template for the second prototype.

#### Prototype Two – 5/25/2012 (APPENDIX A)

Currently in progress is a hi-fi prototype which adds actual feel to the application. Approximately 85% of the prototype is completed.

#### **HOME**

The home screen serves essentially serves as a splash screen leading the user straight to the core function of finding a potential degree.

#### **DEGREE FILTER**

The degree filter is broken into three sections: major, double major and minor. Each section allows for the user to filter majors by either school or career. This is important since many prospective student-athletes (PSAs) are unsure what they want to major in but may know which career they wish to pursue. If filtering by school, the user can select the school they wish to enroll then are given a list of majors supported by the chosen school. A viewable list of degrees is always visible displaying the current majors satisfying the current filter options. As the user selects their school and/or major the list of degrees amends to the filter selections removing the degrees which do not satisfy the chosen options. If filtering by career, users are prompted with filtering by industry then occupation. Like schools, when an industry is selected, occupations for that industry are listed.

#### **DEGREE WORKSHEET**

After choosing a degree users directed to degree information. The information portion is divided into three sections: description, degree worksheet, and course filter. The description provides information about the selected majors including what the major is as well as potential jobs in the selected field. The degree worksheet displays all the classes needed to complete the degree. This sheet can be amended to include a double major and/or minor. Most importantly the sheet allows for users to use the course filter to understand which courses satisfy a particular requirement. If a user wants to know which course will satisfy a History requirement, by simply tapping the requirement, a filtered list of courses is displayed with the course number and title.

#### **GLOBAL**

Users always have direct access to the main navigation located on the left side of the page. Buttons are similar to those usually found on the iPad leading to a shorter learning curve.

#### **HOME**

DePaul University Shield added to add a DePaul feel to the application.

#### **DEGREE WORKSHEET**

Libreal Art requirements are listed as abbreviations (IE: A&L) opposed to an empty line to allow for easy recognition of the actual number of requirements. This also follows the convention used in the "Compare Majors" function to provide consistency when looking at each version of a worksheet. Degree descriptions are more detailed with now include a summary with the possible concentrations, a list of potential internships and a list of potential careers. Also added relevant photos, staff, students, classrooms, to fill wasted white space.

#### **GLOBAL**

Removed unused menu button and added icons specific to the button's intention.


Sub-menus have been redesigned from to have solid miter corners opposed to the out-of-place rounded corners.




### **DEGREE BY COLLEGE FILTERED BY SCHOOL**














## **DEGREE WORKSHEET COURSE FILTER**




### **DEGREE BY COLLEGE FILTERED BY SCHOOL**












COURSES FOR A SPECIFIC MAJOR ARE COLOR CODED. SHARED COURSES ARE COLORED BLACK
